## **FOP ENDORSES GORSUCH!!!**

*Nominee will be an "Outstanding" Supreme Court Justice*

Chuck Canterbury, National President of the Fraternal Order of Police, announced that the National Board of Trustees for the Fraternal Order of Police voted to endorse the nomination of Judge Neil M. Gorsuch to be the next Associate Justice on the Supreme Court of the United States.

"Our members and our leadership know Judge Gorsuch from his time at the U.S. Department of Justice," said Canterbury. "We found him to be an excellent partner and team player with a deep and abiding commitment to the law."

The Senate Committee on the Judiciary held four days of hearings on the nomination and is scheduled to hold a committee vote next week. The nomination is certain to be favorably reported and then it will be considered on the Senate floor.

"The nomination process has become more and more politicized and the process has grown ugly with partisanship, but my members believe Judge Gorsuch acquitted himself with grace and candor during the questioning," Canterbury said. "He demonstrated himself to be an incredibly talented jurist and we believe no fair-minded American would object to his joining the highest court in the land."
