Dear Representative Russell,

I am writing on behalf of the members of the Fraternal Order of Police to advise you of our support for your bill, H.R. 3790, the "Federal Firearms Licensee Protection Act."

According to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF), there has been a 48% increase in the number of burglaries and a 175% increase in the number of robberies over the past five years. In 2016, about 7,758 firearms were stolen from Federal Firearms Licensees (FFLs) in burglaries and robberies.

These stolen firearms invariably turn up in other crimes and present a real danger to public safety. Your legislation would impose a minimum sentence for a successful conviction of not less than three years for burglary and five years for robbery. This is a significant reinforcement of Federal law which will help deter both first-time and repeat offenders and ensure those convicted of these crimes serve serious time.
