**MONTHLY UPDATE:** 

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS SHOT AND KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY





The **National Fraternal Order of Police** reports that as of midnight on July 31, there have been **185** officers shot so far in 2021, **35** of whom were killed by gunfire. There have been **52** ambush-style attacks on law enforcement officers this year (**+126%** from 2020 YTD), which have resulted in **67** officers shot, **17** of whom were killed. The number of ambush-style attacks on law enforcement does not account for ambush-style attacks that resulted in no officers being shot.

# LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS KILLED BY GUNFIRE







The Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) within the U.S. Department of Justice recently published the 2020 Year-End Law Enforcement Officers Shot in the Line of Duty, which contains the research conducted by staff with the National FOP Legislative Office.

In October of 2019, the National Fraternal Order of Police partnered with the National Blue Alert Network to collect and analyze data on reported shootings of law enforcement officers nationwide. Using media monitoring software and general research, National FOP Legislative Office staff has tracked, collected, and analyzed publicly available information to produce the 2020 Year-End Summary on officers shot and killed in the line of duty.

The report contains data on law enforcement officers shot in the line of duty, both fatally and non-fatally, for the express purpose of better understanding the nature and frequency of incidents that could give rise to the issuance of a **Blue Alert**.

These are preliminary numbers and are subject to change. The final report will be published in early 2022.
