 - 2. <u>Post-Janus Update</u> The demise of public-sector unions that many predicted post-Janus simply has not occurred. The courts are consistent in declining to extend/expand Janus. Accordingly, any major changes moving forward are more likely to come from state legislatures. This topic will address post-Janus legislation and litigation. We will introduce the Ballotpedia page wherein all bills from 2018-present and litigation are tracked and summarized.
